

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

You will complete six hours of graduate credit in each 16-week term. All students begin the program with the PM 650 course.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



The MPM program is a two-year program designed for project management professionals with a minimum of two years of project management work experience. Students can begin the program in August or January.
